

Advancing from Sectional to State 2020

1. No later than **Dec. 2**, log in to speechwire.com to make any changes (e.g., cast/crew substitutions, adjustments to any information about your play).
In SpeechWire, you also will complete additional steps to officially register for the overall festival (see instructions, p. 10, [WHSFA Theatre Handbook](#), updated Nov. 23, 2020).

2. All merchandise must be pre-ordered (including commemorative printed programs), but individuals/families are welcome to place orders directly on the [WHSFA website's online store](#).

3. Fees may be paid by check, purchase order, or credit card (3% transaction fee applies); credit card link will be on invoice generated from SpeechWire.

4. Your students, as members of a State performing company, will have access to the virtual platform to attend all *Wisconsin High School Theatre Festival* events for the entire weekend. Complete instructions will be emailed to directors the week of the festival.



5. We have created a schedule for streaming of shows (“scheduled streams”) during the festival weekend: <https://bit.ly/stateoneactsched2020>. Oral responses will happen immediately following the scheduled stream for each show; directors and their students should report to the oral response virtual room corresponding with the one-act room where the show was streamed. **Directors are responsible for communicating this information to their students.** All students do not need to be present, though that is highly encouraged.
6. Even in an online environment, please remind students the following demeanor reminders are important:
 - Be respectful in online spaces.
 - No video/audio recording, nor photography (including phones or other devices).
 - Students in attendance are the responsibility of their school's personnel.
7. Awards, all evaluation sheets, and oral comments from an adjudicator will be available in the assigned homeroom immediately after each performance.
